The internal Plan for the Unity Network and associated MOE's (URA, Jura...) is to help prioritize and guide the internal work that is the support network for the many external projects of the Unity Network.

The central focus of the entire network is LIFE Support, which is the center of the Non-profit. The concept is simply that we MUST support individuals community leaders with basic life necessities to ensure that their personal issues don't prevent our communities from coming together and organizing for a better world.

This is the Overall Internal Plan, and there will be internal plans for each component of the Unity Network as separate documents.

There are two primary Internal Plans that we are created. One is focused on Jay's involvement as the primary founder and leader jump starting the network, and the other is the URA which is the overall organization that coordinates all the external projects and programs.

Overall the pimrary internal goal is recruitment for 3 types of positions. General support of URA projects and programs. Direct Administrative Support for Jay's work to launch the NEtwork, and also direct personal support for Jay's personal life needs to ensure he is able to balance his personal, work, and community commitments.

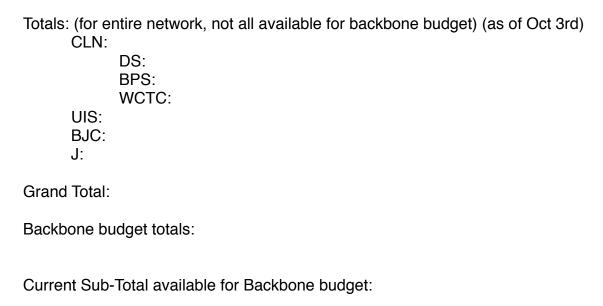
