What are the "Fruits" or Outcomes of the Unity Network?

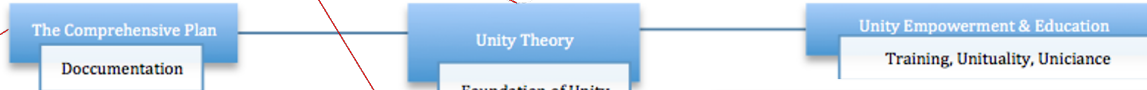
Unity Network Goal: To Implement Unity Theory by creating a variety of activities, documents and interactive methods, accessible to all people of the world, with our Unity Day annual event at the center, that can help Unite All Peoples and Social Movements for Societal Transformation.

Unity Theory is the foundation to unity, and our goal is to see our theory as an equal on the table of all options to solve our global and regional crises. The general concept behind the theory is that we may not be able to solve any one of our global crises without solving all of them, or in other words, we may not be able to protect any single persons rights, with out protecting all rights, because all rights are interconnected, and all problems have common roots.

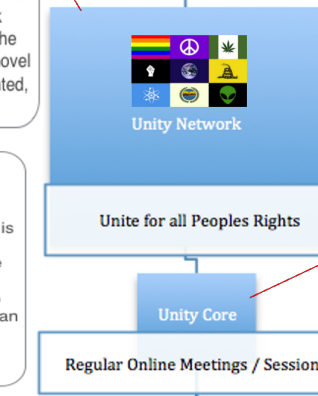
The Comprehensive Plan is the documentation of Unity Theory. Even if we are not successful in implementing Unity Theory, we still intend to create a book that documents the methodology, the step by step plan that is created through the CommUnity Elections prioritization process, and a visual story in the form of a novel which will show what the application of Unity Theory would look like if implemented, and how it would effect normal everyday people, and life on our planet.

Unity Day is the focal event that synchronizes all of the activities and decision making of the Unity Network. On Unity Day we promote to the world the concepts of Unity, including how we feel it is important for all peoples and social movements to unite for societal transformation. This is the day we encourage all people to take to the plazas and streets to remind those in power who really is in charge. This is when we share the image of unity with our Unity Flag, this is when we finalize our annual priority with the yearly community Election, this is when we get people to sign our post card, and send our demands to the decision makers who can directly implement changes. This is the day when the people can come together and form local conventions that make up the foundation of the glocal People's Parallel Governance Systems.

Unity Post Card is our list of Demands that are prioritized out of the Community Elections, but instead of just all ideas, these are the most important actionable items that existing decision makers have the ability to change right away. We deliver our signatures to decision makers on Unity Day.

Unity Flag is the symbolic image of Unity that we have chosen to represent our vision. It is fully interactive and anyone can input any symbol to be prioritized and voted into the Unity Flag. We can also customize flags for nations, states, or local communities. By showing the most iconic symbols of social movements united on a single flag, we hope to ignite the vision of empowerment to all people that Unity brings.

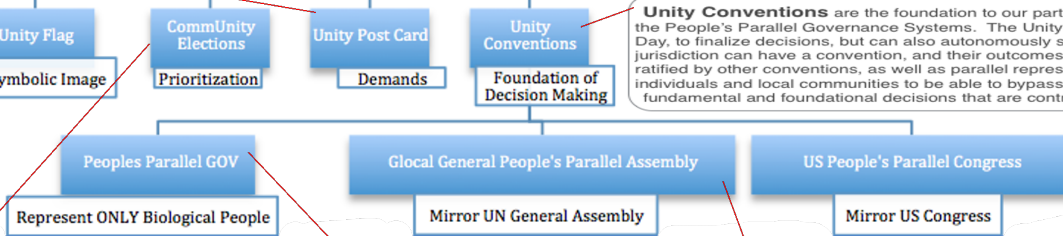
CommUnity Elections are our form of direct democracy. Anyone can input any idea, and vote to prioritize all ideas and proposals that are submitted. Our system treats all ideas as equals no matter where, when, or who they come from, and continually compares each individual idea to steadily prioritize them into successive elections that culminate in the yearly CommUnity Election to choose our annual focus, which is synced with Unity Day.



Unity Education & Empowerment is the individual application of Unity Theory which people can directly access themselves by reading Unity Theory, our book called the Comprehensive Plan, as well as learning about the plethora of other Unity Theories that exist in the world related to science, sudo science, spirituality, religion, and learning about the diversity of social movements that exist in the world, all which affect each individuals understanding of the world that creates their "world view". Our hope is that people will realize what a world view really represents, and how important it is to come to the realization that it just may be the case the other people have VERY different world views than yourself, and that in order for us all to get along and unite, we must respect and give foundational rights each others world views in order to co-exist, and realize that it is wrong to try to impose your world view on others, even if you don't even realize your doing that. This simple realization can create a paradigm shift of conscious understanding and empowerment for individuals, local communities, and all peoples. Additionally we will be doing trainings, workshops, and share circles within our regular online sessions (or Unity Core), where anyone can share anything, if it is prioritized by the group of people who show up.

Unity Core are our on-going meetings, sessions, and activities that people from all over the world can participate in. Currently we can work with people who speak "Globish" (Simplified and slowed down English), as well as Fluent english, and Fluent Spanish. Our hope is to fundraise to be able to have our sessions conducted in dozens of languages. Currently our primary gregorian sessions are on Saturdays, including our Unity Intro Q&A session. We also coordinate natural time sessions that correlate with the Full / New Moon, the Seasons, and the planets including Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, and other planets and dwarf planets that cycle must less frequently. At each open session that the Unity Network supports, any individual, or organization can propose a topic of discussion and help prioritize our goals and outcomes for the session. Projects, Organizations, or spontaneous discussions can use our open sessions as their primary form of communications, as we can have simultaneous sessions that we can connect through proxies.

Unity Conventions are the foundation to our participatory decision making structure within the People's Parallel Governance Systems. The Unity Conventions always take place on Unity Day, to finalize decisions, but can also autonomously self organize. Each regional or local jurisdiction can have a convention, and their outcomes, decisions, and proposals can directly be ratified by other conventions, as well as parallel representative bodies. This directly empowers individuals and local communities to be able to bypass representative bodies for the most fundamental and foundational decisions that are controlled by biological people themselves.



People's Parallel Governance Systems are the representative branch of our decision making, which complete the democratic trilogy of direct democracy, participatory democracy, and representative democracy. There will be NO lobbyists, NO big money interests, NO corporate interests, NO national government interests, ONLY people will be represented. Our primary focal point is to create the Glocal People's Parallel General Assembly so individuals across the world can participate, and the United States People's Parallel Congress so that we can directly challenge the most bought-out legislature, which has 4 lobbyists for every 1 representative. All parallel representatives will run for office as a slate directly against the entirety of the existing official congress of incumbents, with the goal of firing all of them simultaneously. Instead of individual candidates taking "bribes" from rich people, we will run a Single national campaign to get people to Vote for candidates who are NOT raising vast sums of money. The winner of the parallel congress, will be the candidate who gets the most votes with minimal, or NO, reliance on raising money for their election.

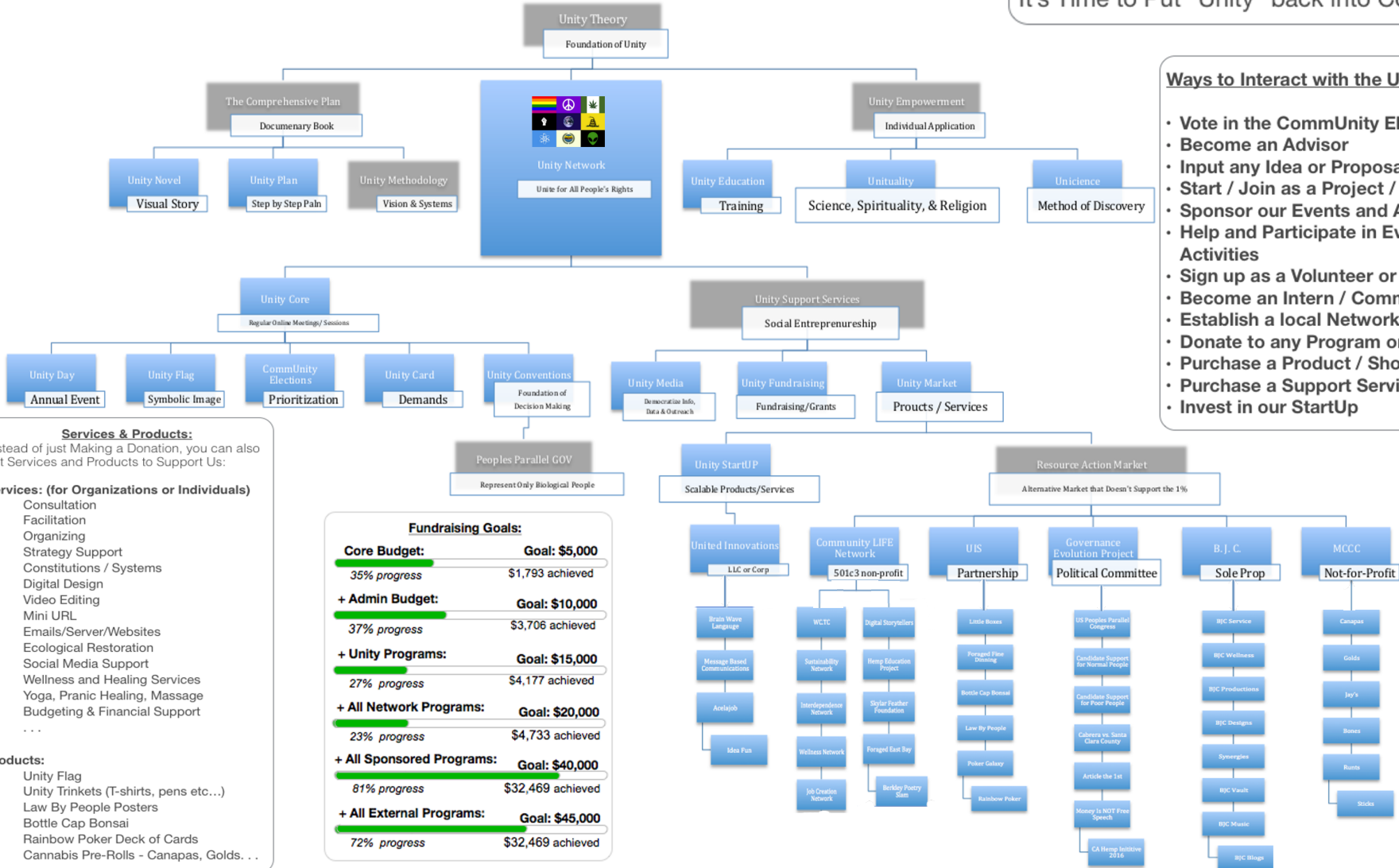

Unity Network Step/Ratchet Fundraising Goals (beyond current Fundraising Campaign)

Here is what can be accomplished at each level of Core Unity Network Funding, including options for paying Executive Staff which would currently be Jay Blas Jacob Cabrera.

- \$2,500 - helps a little bit - doesn't provide much stability
- helps out for 1-2 months (no money for Executive Staff)
- \$5,000 - is really the minimum I need to gain a little stability
- 2-3 months of stability (no money for Executive Staff)
 - Able to establish and stabilize Unity Core!!!! this is HUGE
- \$10,000 - Can launch the Unity Network including Unity Day!
- 6-12 months of stability (no money for Executive Staff)
 - Unity Day 2016 will be announced within 3-6 months
- Going beyond current Fundraising Goals -----
- \$25,000 - can begin to pay Executive Staff
- 12 months + of stability
 - Do a Huge Unity Network Launch with All programs (english, and minor other languages as possible)
 - Basic Parallel Gov structures
 - Can pay Executive Staff a small stipend of about \$300-\$300 per month
- \$50,000 - actually enough for Executive Staff to live off of
- 1-2 years of stability
 - Massive Global Unity Network launch in all languages
 - Stable Parallel GOV structures + basic US People's Parallel congress
 - Can pay Executive Staff a full part time stipend - \$1,000/mo
- \$100,000 - Allows Exclusive Executive focus ALL time and energy on helping society and humanity

 - Expansive Parallel Gove Structures
 - Stable US Congress
 - Basic Global Assembly
 - Start some other countries structures
 - Start Global County/city alternative model
 - Pay Executive Staff a Basic Annual Salary - \$2,500 / mo



Who am I? Jay Blas Jacob Cabrera Unity Network Founder

Community: I currently run a 501c3 non-profit as the Executive Director. We have about a \$65,000 budget which continues to grow every year as we bring on new programs. As an umbrella network, our non-profit functions administratively from my work and my work alone, which I am not paid for. Only 2.4% of our budget goes back to support my administrative work, and we need more funding from outside sources to stabilize our non-profit administrative structures for the long term. There is so much work, and I should be getting paid for it, but we just don't have enough funds. Currently we have over 5 active programs, with our largest programs focused on classroom education in slam poetry for at risk youth. We have over 600 students in five school districts. This is one of my top priorities to ensure these programs continue, and one of the reasons why fundraising is so important for us.

Unity: For over 3 years, since Occupy, I have been working on developing the systems and methodology for Unity, and I am currently in "Pre-Launch" mode waiting for enough funding to do a Full Launch. I took all the best parts of Occupy, and added in a lot of other essential components for a smooth societal transformation. The focal point is Unity Day which is our annual event to take to the streets and remind the people in power who is really in control. The primary structure is a parallel governance system that both mirrors existing governance bodies and allows for alternative experimental evolution of governance at all levels.

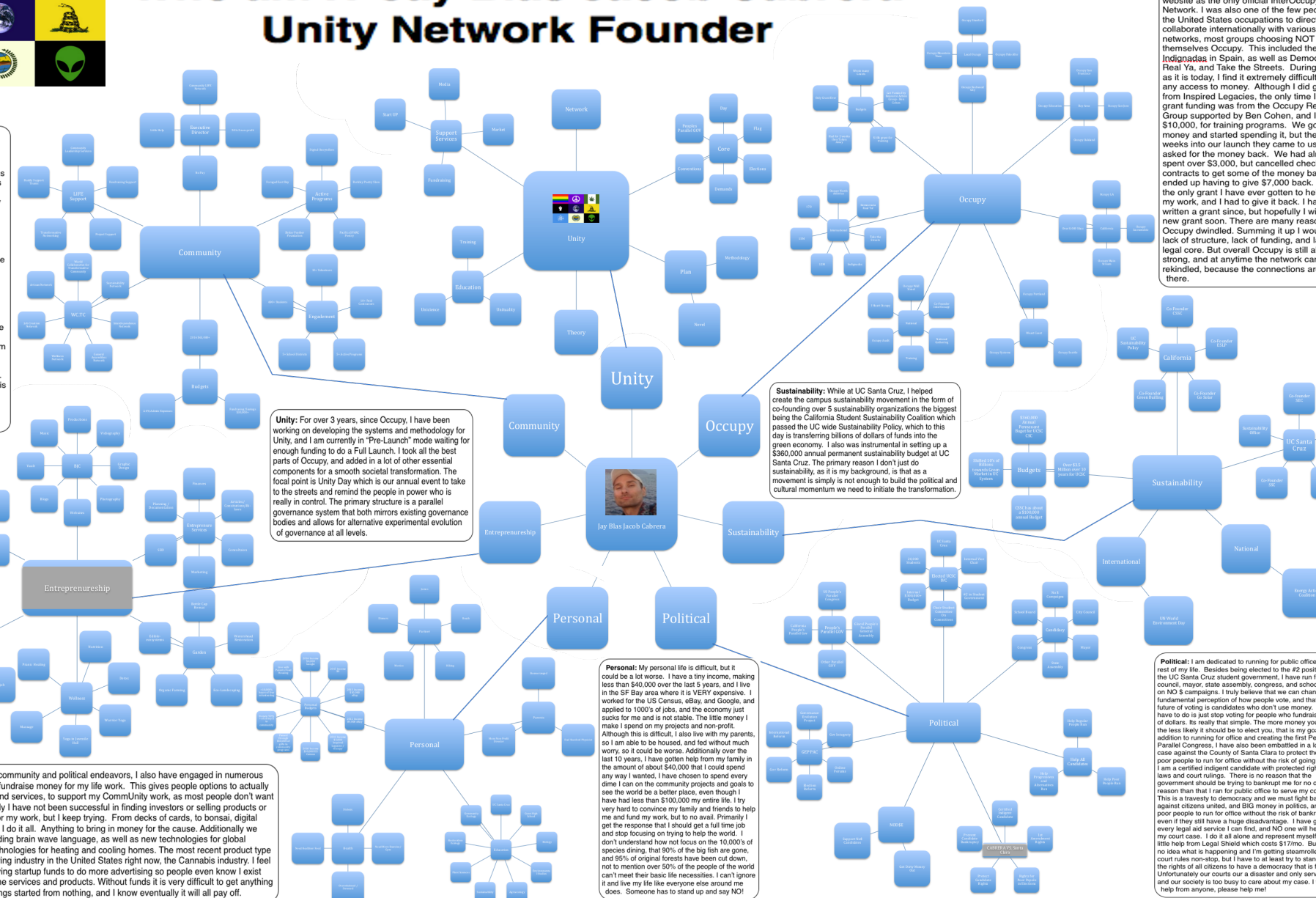
Sustainability: While at UC Santa Cruz, I helped create the campus sustainability movement in the form of co-founding over 5 sustainability organizations the biggest being the California Student Sustainability Coalition which passed the UC wide Sustainability Policy, which to this day is transferring billions of dollars of funds into the green economy. I also was instrumental in setting up a \$360,000 annual permanent sustainability budget at UC Santa Cruz. The primary reason I don't just do sustainability, as it is my background, is that as a movement is simply is not enough to build the political and cultural momentum we need to initiate the transformation.

Personal: My personal life is difficult, but it could be a lot worse. I have a tiny income, making less than \$40,000 over the last 5 years, and I live in the SF Bay area where it is VERY expensive. I worked for the US Census, eBay, and Google, and applied to 1000's of jobs, and the economy just sucks for me and is not stable. The little money I make I spend on my projects and non-profit. Although this is difficult, I also live with my parents, so I am able to be housed, and fed without much worry, so it could be worse. Additionally over the last 10 years, I have gotten help from my family in the amount of about \$40,000 that I could spend any way I wanted. I have chosen to spend every dime I can on the community projects and goals to see the world be a better place, even though I have had less than \$100,000 my entire life. I try very hard to convince my family and friends to help me and fund my work, but to no avail. Primarily I get the response that I should get a full time job and stop focusing on trying to help the world. I don't understand how not focus on the 10,000's of species dying, that 90% of the big fish are gone, and 95% of original forests have been cut down, not to mention over 50% of the people of the world can't meet their basic life necessities. I can't ignore it and live my life like everyone else around me does. Someone has to stand up and say NO!

Entrepreneurship: Besides community and political endeavors, I also have engaged in numerous entrepreneurial ideas to try to fundraise money for my life work. This gives people options to actually invest, or purchase products and services, to support my CommUnity work, as most people don't want to give donations. Unfortunately I have not been successful in finding investors or selling products or services to fundraise money for my work, but I keep trying. From decks of cards, to bonsai, digital design, websites, and healing. I do it all. Anything to bring in money for the cause. Additionally we have a few startup ideas including brain wave language, as well as new technologies for global transparency and using old technologies for heating and cooling homes. The most recent product type has to do with the fastest growing industry in the United States right now, the Cannabis industry. I feel like the biggest obstacle is having startup funds to do more advertising so people even know I exist and am offering these awesome services and products. Without funds it is very difficult to get anything started, but I still try to get things started from nothing, and I know eventually it will all pay off.

Occupy: During 2011-2012 I was heavily involved in Occupy. In addition to co-founding my local occupations, I also was a co-founder for the national InterOccupy group, which is still operational and is linked off the official OWS website as the only official InterOccupy Network. I was also one of the few people from the United States occupations to directly collaborate internationally with various networks, most groups choosing NOT to call themselves Occupy. This included the Indignadas in Spain, as well as Democracia Real Ya, and Take the Streets. During Occupy, as it is today, I find it extremely difficult to get any access to money. Although I did get \$2,000 from Inspired Legacies, the only time I got a full grant funding was from the Occupy Resources Group supported by Ben Cohen, and I received \$10,000, for training programs. We got the money and started spending it, but then three weeks into our launch they came to us and asked for the money back. We had already spent over \$3,000, but cancelled checks and contracts to get some of the money back, and ended up having to give \$7,000 back. This is the only grant I have ever gotten to help fund my work, and I had to give it back. I haven't written a grant since, but hopefully I will find a new grant soon. There are many reasons why Occupy dwindled. Summing it up I would say, lack of structure, lack of funding, and lack of a legal core. But overall Occupy is still alive and strong, and at anytime the network can be rekindled, because the connections are all still there.

Political: I am dedicated to running for public office for the rest of my life. Besides being elected to the #2 position within the UC Santa Cruz student government, I have run for city council, mayor, state assembly, congress, and school board on NO 5 campaigns. I truly believe that we can change the fundamental perception of how people vote, and that the future of voting is candidates who don't use money. All we have to do is just stop voting for people who fundraise millions of dollars. Its really that simple. The more money you raise, the less likely it should be to elect you, that is my goal. In addition to running for office and creating the first People's Parallel Congress, I have also been embattled in a long court case against the County of Santa Clara to protect the rights of poor people to run for office without the risk of going bankrupt. I am a certified indigent candidate with protection within laws and court rulings. There is no reason that the government should be trying to bankrupt me for no other reason than that I ran for public office to serve my country. This is a travesty to democracy and we must fight back against citizens united, and BIG money in politics, and allow poor people to run for office without the risk of bankruptcy even if they still have a huge disadvantage. I have gone to every legal aid service with protection, and I'm getting steamrolled on court rules non-stop, but I have to at least try to stand up for the rights of all citizens to have a democracy that is fair. Unfortunately our courts are a disaster and only serve lawyers, and our society is too busy to care about my case. I will take help from anyone, please help me!
